

Tata Power Company is currently trading at Rs. 82.65, up by 0.80 points or 0.98 % from its previous closing of Rs. 81.85 on the BSE.

The scrip opened at Rs. 82.20 and has touched a high and low of Rs. 83.10 and Rs. 81.50 respectively. So far 697577 shares were traded on the counter.

The BSE group 'A' stock of face value Rs. 1 has touched a 52 week high of Rs. 83.35 on 20-Oct-2016 and a 52 week low of Rs. 55.00 on 12-Feb-2016.

Last one week high and low of the scrip stood at Rs. 83.35 and Rs. 77.40 respectively. The current market cap of the company is Rs. 22421.38 crore.

The promoters holding in the company stood at 33.02%, while institutions and noninstitutions held 50.71% and 16.12% respectively.
