Deal in line with Centre's aim of 30 GW of offshore wind installations by 2030

Tata Power and German electricity generating company RWE have agreed on a partnership to explore the potential for a joint development of offshore wind projects in India.

A MoU has been signed between Tata Power Renewable Energy, a 100 percent subsidiary of Tata Power which is one of India's largest integrated power companies, and RWE Renewables GmbH, one of the world's leaders in offshore wind.

#### **Identifying potential**

Both will conduct technical and commercial site assessments and evaluate Indian offshore wind supply chain and supporting infrastructure, such as ports and grid connections, to identify the local strengths as well as necessary development potential.

#### **Global expertise**

Praveer Sinha, CEO and Managing Director of Tata Power, said: "RWE is our ideal partner to support Tata Power's plans to enhance and grow offshore wind business based on its global expertise in running and operating offshore wind projects."

#### **Unexplored market**

The companies state that India is an unexplored and highly attractive market to develop opportunities for offshore wind as it has a large coastline of about 7,600 km.
